

Christmas Door Stop

Materials :-

- Four different Christmas fabrics – 8 inches wide each
- Tone on tone fabric – for base and stars – 8 inches wide
- Iron-on Pellon – 30 x 8 inches
- Matching thread, general sewing supplies
- DMC threads – 469 (Avocado Green), 400 (DK Mahogany), 321 (Red), 444 (DK Lemon), 898 (DK Red) & 895 (V DK Hunter Green)
- Filling (Rice, Wheat and Lavender or clean dry sand)

Instructions :-

- To make a triangle, measure onto cardboard, $6 \frac{1}{8}$ inch across the base and $6 \frac{1}{8}$ inch from centre of base to the peak and from the peak draw a line to

each end of the base line. Cut out four triangle shapes from each of the four fabrics.

- Cut one square 6 1/8" x 6 1/8" from the Tone on tone fabric
- Cut four triangle shapes and one square shape from the iron-on Pellon
- Cut one, 4 x 2 inch rectangle from one of the Christmas fabrics

Take a light and dark triangle and sew together with right sides along the peak to base.

Do the same with the other two triangles. Don't sew these two lots together just yet.

Fold the 4 x 2 inch rectangle wrong sides together in half and press. Fold over the edges 1/4 inch into the centre (wrong sides tog) then machine sew along the edge and again on the other edge with matching thread. This makes the loop.

With right sides together place the two lots of joined triangles together and pin. Place the sewn loop onto the top on the right side of the triangles. Pin into place and sew up the seam and enclosing this tag into the seam. Fold out and lightly press.



Using a light box or window trace the two designs onto the Tone on tone fabric and embroider the patterns using the DMC threads.

Tree - 469 - Back stitch

Pot - 400 - Back stitch

Candles on tree - 321 - Back stitch

Star - 444 - Back stitch

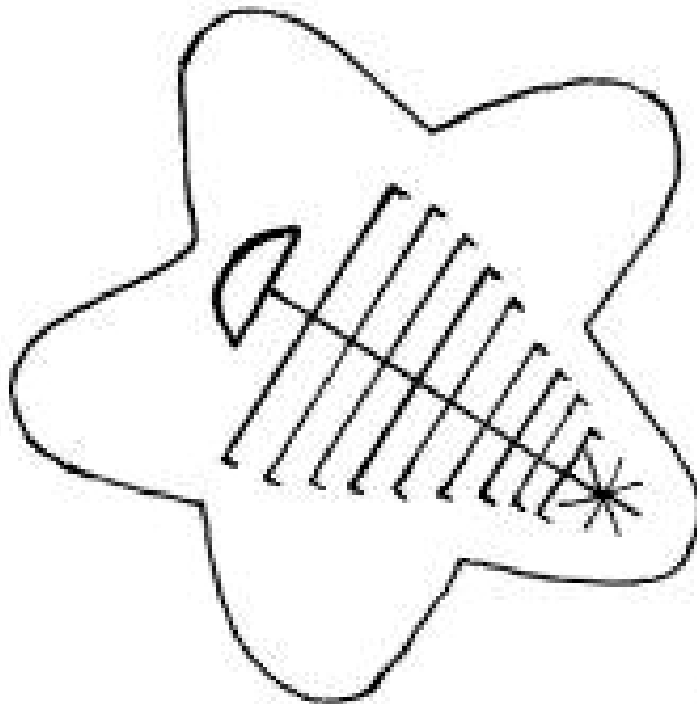
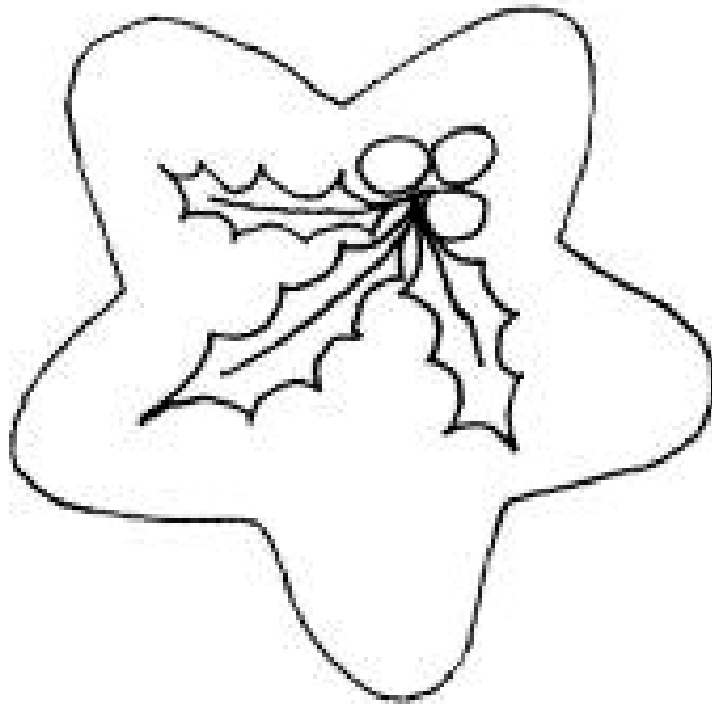
Berries - 898 - Back stitch

Holly Leaves - 895 - Back stitch

Cut out the Star shapes on the lines and appliqué these shapes onto the dark fabric triangles using DMC 898 thread and Blanket Stitch.

Machine sew the two raw edges of the triangles with right sides together and sew the bottom square onto these with right sides together matching the corners with the seams of the triangles and leave an opening of 2 inches.

Turn the Door stop into the right way and fill with the filling of choice. Sew the opening closed.
